"Opposites is a reference to my work about both sides of the Atlantic, my journeys around the USA and the harbour-towns of Cornwall."

Ashley Hanson's paintings embrace geography and the dialogue and tensions between 'opposites' i.e. between freedom and control, the natural and the man-made landscape, the curved and the linear, and in his latest 'City of Glass' series of paintings (inspired by Paul Auster's novel 'The New York Trilogy') he explores the relationship between fact and fiction.

Last year Ashley was joint winner of the Canvas and Cream Art Prize in London and his work was also selected for the Discerning Eye, the National Open Art Competition and the Ludlow Open. In addition Ashley was selected for the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition in 2011.

To coincide with this exhibition Ashley will be in the gallery to discuss his work on Sat May 18, 12pm -2pm and Sat June 22, 12-2pm.
